

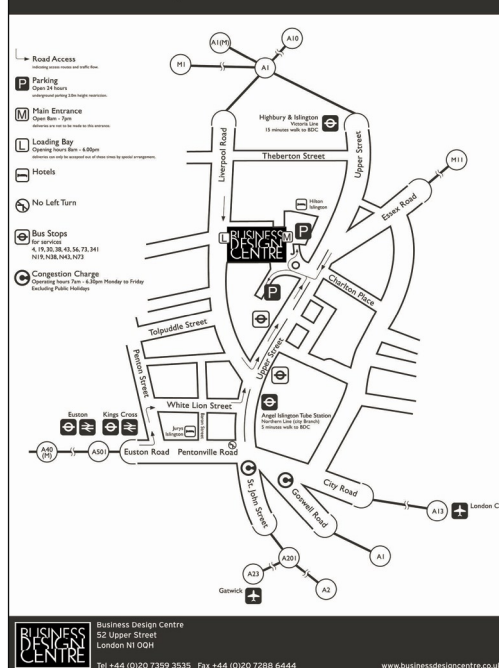
Location details

The Henshall Centre's permanent training suite is located inside the Business Design Centre, in Suite 145A.

Our picture shows the main entrance to this striking building. It is set back slightly from Upper Street with traffic lights at its entrance. Please note that this is the only entrance to the building. You will not be allowed access from Liverpool Road. That is the loading bay for trade show exhibitors.

Once inside the main entrance, go to the concierge desk. It is on the left as you enter the building. Avoid the desk on the right. That is where trade show visitors register.

The concierge will issue you with a name badge. Please wear it at all times while in the building.

Concierge staff will direct you to us. Normally, you enter the main hall, turn left and follow the blue carpet until you see the Henshall Centre sign standing outside Suite 145A on your right. Tea and coffee is served inside our suite.

Staying near the Business Design Centre

Immediately alongside the Business Design Centre, there is a fully air-conditioned, four star Hilton International hotel. This is very nice indeed. A short walk away, on the Pentonville Road, is a Jury's Inn. This is fine. A short taxi ride away, there is a Premier Travel Inn on York Road, King's Cross. This is cheap, cheerful and reliable and has a nice atrium courtyard as part of its restaurant.

Getting to the Business Design Centre

TUBE

Go to Angel station on the Northern Line. When you come through the ticket barrier, you are looking along Upper Street in the direction you need to walk. There is a sign to the Business Design Centre painted on the inside wall above the station exit.

Walk along Upper Street, initially staying on the same side of the road as the station. You pass three sets of traffic lights. The first set is right outside Angel station. Walk past that set. At the second set (after about 100m), cross Upper Street and continue walking in the same direction. At the third set (another 60m or so) look to your left. You should see the Business Design Centre as we have pictured it.

You can also go to Highbury & Islington on the Victoria Line, You are then at the top of the map. So you walk down Upper Street, about 1km. The Business Design Centre is now on your right.

BUS

Numerous bus routes pass along Upper Street. Ask for the Business Design Centre. If that is not recognised, you want the junction of Upper Street and Essex Road.

CAR

Upper Street is the A1. There is on-site car parking at £2.30 per hour, but there are only 100 places. The Centre is just north of the congestion charge zone which starts at Pentonville Road/City Road at the bottom of our map.
