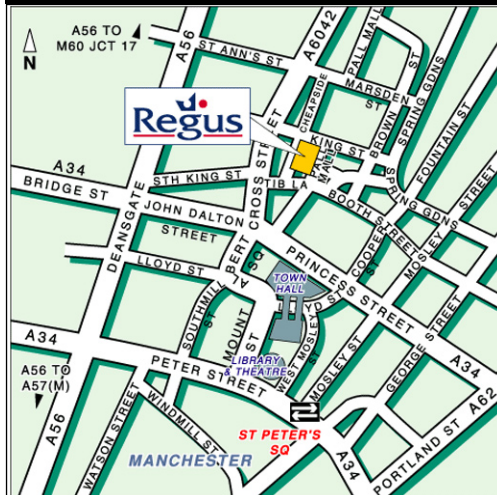

The Henshall Centre rents training rooms from the Regus Centre in King Street in Manchester's financial district.

82 (pictured) is an imposing, Grade I listed, sandstone building. It was once the Bank of England. Nowadays Regus occupies the upper floors.

Be warned. The number 82, carved above the door, is not easy to spot. However, the building is surrounded by very modern office blocks, whose numbers are very easy to see. So look out for number 56. It is very clearly marked and is directly opposite number 82.

Once inside 82, go to the third floor, where you will find the Regus reception desk. They will direct you to the room. Tea and coffee are served inside the room.

Staying near the King Street Regus Centre

Manchester's city centre is full of excellent hotels. Two to note: The four star Midland hotel has just had a £12m upgrade. It is very plush. In the shadows of this swanky building there is a Premier Travel Inn. Like others in this chain, it is cheap, cheerful and reliable. It has a rather nice restaurant next door with views of the G-Mex centre. Modern Metrolink trams glide right by its glazed front.

Both hotels are a short walk, from St Peter's Square, to King Street.

Getting to the King Street Regus Centre

METROLINK

Manchester's signature trams, the Metrolink service, stop at three locations close to King Street. Market Street, Moseley Street and St. Peter's Square are all a short walk to King Street. If you are not familiar with Manchester, you may need a map or A-Z for that short walk.

CAR

If you are not familiar with Manchester, you need to be aware that at peak times, its traffic jams stand comparison with London's fiercest gridlock. No matter which point of the compass you approach from.

There are two huge NCP car parks located directly under the G-Mex Centre, alongside the two hotels that we have already mentioned.

TRAIN

King Street is very central. It is pretty much equidistant from the Piccadilly, Victoria, Deansgate and Oxford Road train stations. All four stations are about a 10-15 minute walk away.

The Metro Shuttle, a complimentary bus, runs from each of these stations. Bus number ONE stops right outside the Regus Centre.
